Doncaster

Originally one of Victoria's best producing regions, the orchards were progressively subdivided for residential development through the 1950s, 60s and 70s.

Today, Doncaster is a well-established and highly sought after residential and commercial area. Over the coming decades, we can expect to see Doncaster continue to grow with the development of Doncaster Hill, located around Westfield Doncaster.

Westfield Doncaster is Manningham's key retail destination. A multiplex shopping centre with vast parking capacity, the centre caters for an array of shopping needs - from major department stores to independent boutiques across fashion, dining, technology and entertainment. It attracts visitors from outside Manningham as well as from within the local area.

Doncaster has seen a growth in population across all household types, in particular in Doncaster Hill and along main roads. This growth is expected to increase further as construction works at Tullamore and Doncaster Hill are completed.

Doncaster is also home to Ruffey Lake Park, one of the most popular and highly visited open spaces in Manningham.




